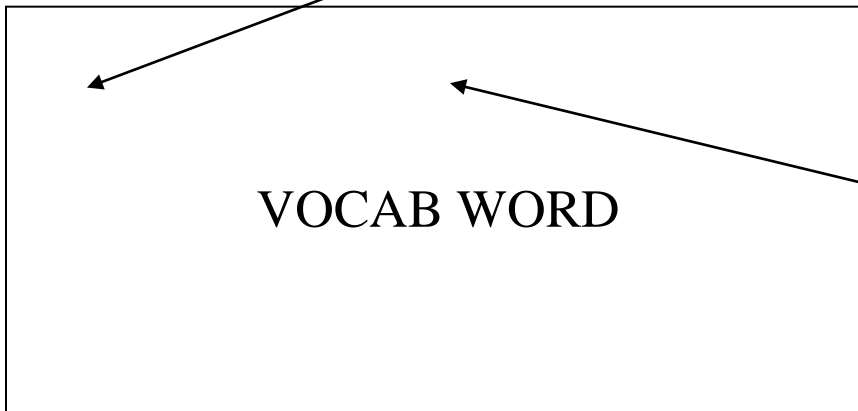


FLASHCARD REQUIREMENTS

- Use one 3x5 card for each vocabulary word
- Each card is worth one point
- All sections of the card must be complete to get the point for the card
- Label the top card in MLA format with your NAME, TEACHER, CLASS, DATE, AND THE ASSIGNMENT TITLE centered at the top (ex. Book & chapter)
- Use a rubber band to hold your cards together when submitting them for grading (available in classroom unless rubber bands are not being used appropriately).
- DO NOT bend the cards by rubber banding them too tight.
- If you run out of cards, you may cut “cards” from plain white printer paper, as long as the flashcards are cut neatly and are all the same size.

FRONT OF CARD:

If this is the top/first card, then your MLA heading will go in the top left-hand corner.



The title of which vocab it is gets centered at the top of the first card, near the MLA heading (only needed on the top card).

BACK OF CARD:

Definition	Synonym (try to find one word with the same meaning , but you may use a phrase if necessary)
Antonym (try to find one word with the opposite meaning , but you may use a phrase if necessary)	Picture
