

PROPAGANDA AT ITS BEST GROUPING & MATERIALS NEEDED

Don't get too excited—you will not get to eat the product, nor will you want to!

GROUPS:

- Choose a group of four people. Only in special circumstances, will you may be allowed to work in a group of three or five (depending upon how many students are in the class).
- Choose partners realizing that you will work collaboratively on the project and you will get the same grade.
- Choose partners who will contribute equally, and who you know you can rely on.
- Exchange some form of contact information in case you need to get ahold of your partners on a non-class day.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 1.) 1 to 4 cups/pounds of shortening (ie. Crisco)—1 cup is only enough for a small, single-scoop cone—more shortening is needed for bowls or multi-scoop cones
- 2.) Powdered sugar (1 pound is enough, unless you are making a huge ice-cream bowl—just realize that the more shortening you use, the more powdered sugar you will need)
- 3.) Ice cream cone or fancy bowl to display ice cream
- 4.) Medium to Large mixing bowl
- 5.) 1 or 2 large mixing spoons
- 6.) 1 or 2 small spoons (optional, but often helpful)
- 7.) Ice cream scoop
- 8.) Measuring cups
- 9.) Dish soap (for cleaning dishes afterwards)
- 10.) Roll of paper towels or 2-3 hand towels (You are responsible for cleaning any mess you make, so bring anything else that you think may be helpful for clean-up.)
- 11.) **(Optional)** Toppings of your choice (ie. Cocoa if you want your ice cream to look chocolate flavored, strawberry jam if you want it to look strawberry flavored, food coloring, sprinkles, whip cream, cherries, etc.)
