


SAMPLE FLASHCARDS

EXAMPLES from the Elements of a Story Vocabulary


Front of card says: Plot

Back of card:

<p>The action or sequence of events in a story. It is usually a series of related incidents that build upon one another as the story develops.</p>	<p>Storyline</p>
<p>Random, unrelated events</p>	


Front of card says: Plot Line

Back of card:

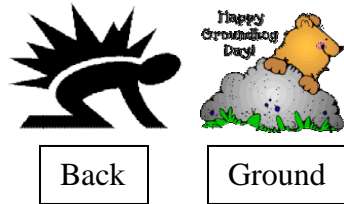
<p>The graphic display of the action or events in a story: exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution</p>	<p>Story Mountain</p>
<p>Illogical order</p>	

Front of card says: Exposition

Back of Card:

Is writing that is intended to explain something that might otherwise be difficult to understand. In a play or novel, it would be the portion that gives the background or situation surrounding the story.	Background

Front of card says: Rising Action

Back of Card:

The series of struggles that builds a story or play toward a climax.	Problems increase interest
