Things to notice in the sample Works Cited above:

- 1.) The entries are NOT numbered.
- 2.) The entries are in alphabetical order.
- 3.) The entire works cited is double spaced, but there are no EXTRA spaces between entries.
- 4.) The font is Times New Roman, size 12, for every word in the document.
- 5.) The color of the font is always black
- 6.) If an entry is longer than one line, then all other lines after the first line are indented. This is called a hanging indent.
- 7.) The author's name is NOT in all caps. Sometimes the databases make this error, so be sure to correct it when typing out your works cited.
- 8.) The date of access is no longer needed for MLA 8. Sometimes the databases include it in their works cited, so be sure to delete it when typing out your works cited page.
- 9.) Use 1 inch margins. (Exception: do not change the margins on the template for the brochure assignment)
- 10.) Always end every entry with a period.
- 11.) Titles of websites, newspapers, & databases are italicized. Names of articles are in quotations.
